

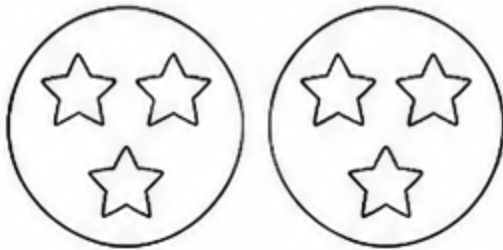

Picture Division Groups

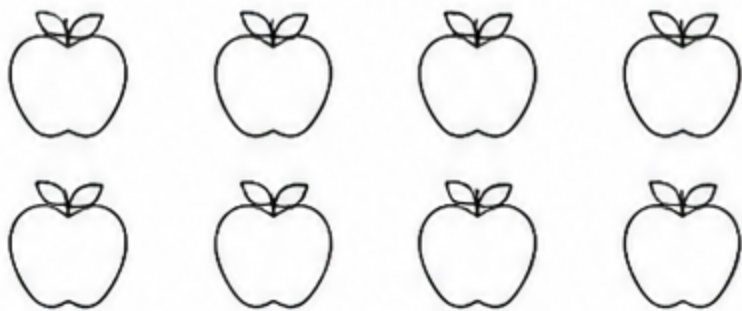
Draw circles to group the pictures equally. Then write a division sentence to show how many groups and how many in each group.

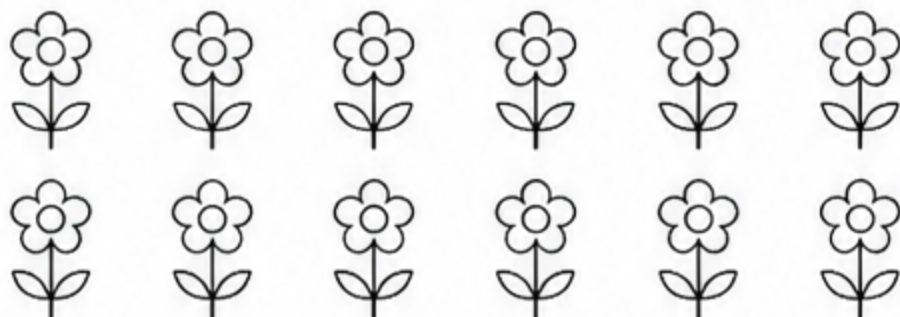

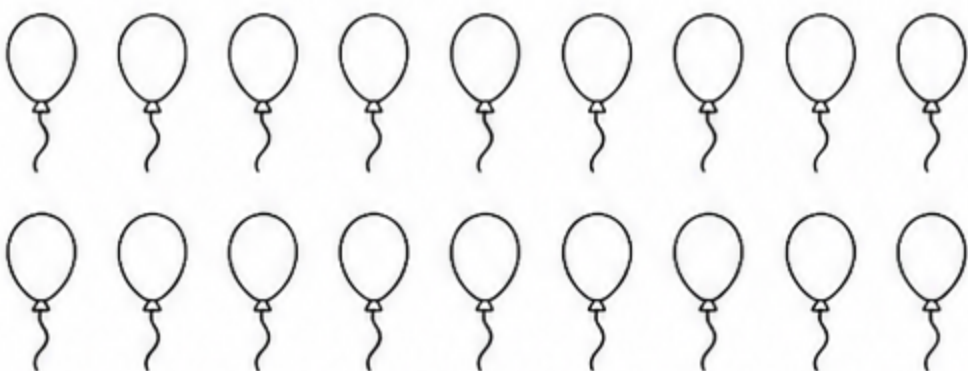
